May I ask for your further assistance in classifying some details about Mr Sobukwe's years at Fort Hare?

1. It would be helpful to know for what purpose Mr Dent wrote the statement which you kindly sent me
2. Was Mr Sobukwe a member of the SRC during 1948?
3. Is it possible to let me have a list of the subjects which he studied, even if the grades are not available?
4. Is it possible to let me know who paid his tuition and hostel fees? Specifically, that is, what bursaries he received?

I do hope you will not mind my firing these questions at you. I have, I believe, been able to amass quite a lot of detail about that time but there are tantalising gaps and uncertainties, especially in regard to his relationship with his old school, Healdtown.

In fact, if there are any details at all about Mr Sobukwe available in your files I would be deeply grateful to be able to have access to them.
