Dear Mrs Sobukwe,

I have checked on the times of trains to Cape Town and the information is as follows:

Sunday, Sept. 4: 10.30 am: Leave Johannesburg.
Monday, Sept. 5: 2 pm: Arrive Cape Town.

This seems to be an excellent time for you to leave here and to get to Cape Town in plenty of time for seeing the Chief Magistrate on the Tuesday morning.

For leaving Cape Town, you could get one of two trains:

Friday, Sept. 9: 9 pm, arriving Johannesburg on the Sunday at 6.30 am., OR

Saturday, Sept. 10: 10.30 am, arriving Johannesburg on the Sunday at 2 pm.

I hope you will be making the bookings soon for these trains. Will you please let me know what arrangements you make?

I have pleasure in enclosing an amount of R45, which is to cover the following:

R25.93.....2nd class return rail ticket
1.20.....cost of bedding to Cape Town and back
17.50.....one quarter of your salary for September.

As arranged, I shall forward the rest of the money, for the hotel, etc, shortly before you leave.

I have written to Mrs Stott and have asked her to go ahead and make the necessary hotel booking for you.
