Dear Mr. Pogrud,

Thank you very much indeed for your prompt letter. I also received a card from the postal authorities, indicating that ~~your~~ my letter to you had arrived. However, I have not received this card from the postal authorities concerning my letter to Mr. Sobukwe. I fear that my letter to him has been lost. I would therefore greatly appreciate your telephoning him.

I have discussed the possibility that we may have planned to overload Mr. Sobukwe with work with the President of Roosevelt University. As a result, we are prepared to drop the arrangement with the Adlai Stevenson Foundation. Mr. Sobukwe would only teach at Roosevelt University, and only two courses one term (Fall) and three the other (Spring) term. This would leave adequate time for Mr. Sobukwe to work on a Ph.D. in linguistics, at either Northwestern University, or the University of Chicago. The salary will remain, of course, as I originally described it, and we will also pay the transportation costs for Mr. Sobukwe and his family.

I believe that this position will be, as you urge, a "quiet" one, although Chicago is, of course, a big (and therefore interesting) city.
