fine indeed and reports that they were being mined and dined in true Cape Town fashion. I should have liked my daughter to have met you. I am sorry she didn't. They left on Saturday, 21st January. Then on Friday, 3rd February, my priest-brother paid me a visit.

I am sorry I am not a U.C.T. graduate. It would have been a pleasure to cast my vote. However, I was very pleased to note that Professors A. C. Jordan and Kunene were among the sponsors of our candidate.

Incidentally, did you stop sending The Listener, or you own or were you told to stop? The last issue I have is of June, 1966. I had asked my wife to

get me that information from  
 you but apparently she couldn't.  
 I realize that you must be  
 very busy these days. I shall  
 therefore, keep this letter short and  
 write again when our pulses have  
 returned to normal. In the  
 meantime let us give the  
 prohibitionists a run for their  
 money.
