A campaign against the arrying of passes by Africans was announced at a PAC meeting at Langa yesterday.

The President, Mr. R.M. Sobukwe, said the campaign would be non-violent. On a specified day, all African men would leave their passes at home, march to the nearest police station and give themselves up.

The date of the campaign would be announced three days in advance.

The campaign would not be called off until the Pass Laws had been taken off the Statute book, a minimum weekly wage of £8. 6. 8. was granted, and a promise of no victimisation given.

The best would be the start of a programme lasting until 1963. If taken to court, members would not plead, or seek bail.
