Dear Sirs,

For some time past you have been supplying fortnightly parcels of fresh fruit to Mr R.M. Sobukwe, care of The Officer Commanding, Robben Island Gaol, Robben Island. Mr Sobukwe has been paying for these parcels out of his own funds which probably reach you via the jail authorities.

With Mr Sobukwe's consent, I would like to take over the payment for these fruit parcels. In the circumstances, I thought it best to write direct to you and to let you have my cheque. Mr Sobukwe advises me that he understands that six months' supply costs about R14,00, and I accordingly have pleasure in enclosing my cheque for this amount.

I shall be glad if you will be good enough to advise me when the period covered by this money expires so that, if necessary I can let you have a further payment.
