

In reply to a question from Mrs. Suzman, Mr. Vorster said Robert Sobukwe, now being imprisoned indefinitely on Robben Island, would not be given a one-way exit permit because he had not changed his views and would operate from outside.

Introducing the debate, Mr. Vorster challenged the International Red Cross to publish the report of their representative who had visited Sobukwe, inspected the prisoners and interrogated 90-day detainees in various parts of the country.

He also challenged other countries — especially African States — to throw open their prisons for Red Cross inspection.

Mr. Vorster said the organization had his full permission to publish its reports on South African prisons.
