My dearest Vera.

I was most delighted to have your last letter and to learn that you are about to finish College soon. Do not mind me not replying you sooner, believe me it is often very difficult for me and I can not explain any reasons. However, I am glad you are doing well & will get an four feet soon.

I have had letters from mama, and am quite aware how things are generally with you. I am sorry I can do no more at present to make it any easier for you though you may be sure, that I am doing all I can.

Mama will receive a personal regard from me by one who was recently here. If you could manage to see him you also could find out all about my existence. I am trying my very utmost to get it arranged for mama to receive a monthly salary. But it is terribly difficult just now on safe of the rate of exchange being so bad against us. It may of course change

And than of course you would be much  
better off. I was wanting to send you some  
thing but we & Mr. H. went through all the  
moscow shops, but very could get nothing  
worth while. I have some money I could  
get you some things bought, but at present  
there is nothing interesting. I will look  
for a chance may be at Vladivostok,  
where I am going shortly.  
When I get back to moscow next year  
we will see perhaps you may like to come  
to moscow. I will write & tell you then.
