I let you know that I did receive your letter with great happiness Sir, I heard what you said, even when you said the owner of the horse said he wanted its money as soon as possible, but at this moment, I do not even have a shilling in my sack (pockets). what I had I spent it all because of the many troubles we had ~~etc~~ during the course of the year. Any-way I am <sup>aware</sup> ~~sure~~ that I owe the horse I bought your daughter some corn. I will pay £40 for the horse - forty pounds. Do not be ~~too~~ sad my friend. I will send the money ~~with~~ with Weil as you said. Even if I do not send it now it ~~will~~ <sup>is</sup> just because I do not have it now; but it won't be a year before I send it.

We stop there Morolong, greetings to you and your wife Queen Mrs Salas.
