We heard of your Capetown trip by Sis Mary-Mrs Mactela at Plumstead. I believe General Hertzoq gave you a favourable hearing.

Sorry to learn that the crops have failed - Plenty out here - we have been reaping - the whole of last month.

Sorry to learn of the Chief's ill health - wishing him a speedy recovery. Go a bonala o antse thata I understand he seized two of my oxen & sold them - He alleges that I was in arrears & rent of farm - me legale ga keitse goe amo the oka a gapeloe a seo, le gone asa itsisiwe sepe.

I am sure something will happen - I don't feel like keeping quiet this time.

Ke utlow moloma are wa re diflesa di uculoe ke batho ba motati - Bad luck - Too bad.
