Oh what a big sorrow! We say we heard you Morolong, what can we do or say let ~~to~~ the removals be done? did you leave your place with your deeds, to tell the truth if you left it will be my responsibility alone.

Theleso of Motema, I heard, we will answer your ~~words~~ words. Lord Gaboutwelwe and lord Lenkwane told us on the 13th July, 1904.
