

Memorandum of Agreement made and entered into
at Mafeking the 30th Day of May 1912
Between Silas Tsoana Molema of Mafeking of the
one part, and J F McIntyes also of
Mafeking of the other part

The said Silas Tsoana Molema herein after called the Lessor
agrees to let to the said J F McIntyes herein after
called the Lessee, who agrees to hire a certain piece
of garden on the Molopo Native Reserve west of
Mafeking, a portion of the Farm known as Kromdraai
the property of the Lessor according to the tribal right and
Custom on the following terms and Conditions

- 1 The Tenency shall be for a term of one year commencing
on the 30th Day of May 1912 and ending on the 30th of
May 1913
- 2 That in the consideration of the said Lessee ploughing
the said piece of garden he agrees to give half of
all the produce to the said Lessor and failing that
the Lessee shall pay to the Lessor in Cash 20/- per a
months commencing from the 30th Day of May as above
mentioned or pay in Stock of the Value mentioned
in this same paragraph which is £12 per a year.
- 3 The Lessee shall during his tenency have the right to keep
open graze on the said portion and on the adjoining native
Reserve all Cattle, Sheep, goats, horses which he may require for his
own use
- 4 The Lessee shall abide and keep the Borolong Custom in
respect of his occupation of the said portion of garden and
in respect of running Cattle, Sheep, goats &c on the
adjoining Native Reserve
- 5 It is lastly stipulated and agreed between the parties
hereto that should either of them at any time commit any
breach of any Condition herein contained it shall and may
be lawful for the other should he so desire it to declare
this agreement to be cancelled, void and of no effect
