

Deed of Lease made and entered into at
 Mafeking Bechuana Land Cape Province
 South Africa On the Day of June 1924
 by and between Silas Faana Motema of Mafeking
 Esquire hereinafter styled Executor
 and Guardian of Mametsi Mndoro of Basiride
 Mantsiwa and her step son Mokohe Mantsiwa
 hereinafter styled the Lessor of the one part and
 Madroosus Dusuqi Presently of Mafeking hereinafter styled
 the Lessee of the other Part
 Witnesses

- 1 The Lessor hereby lets to the Lessee who hereby
 hires from him the Farm Darendale situated
 in the District of Mafeking Cape Province
- 2 The Rent payable by the Lessee to the Lessor
 shall be the Sum of Thirty Pounds (£ 30 - -)
 Per Annum payable in advance half yearly
 the first Payment to be made in signing
 thereof
- 3 The period of this Lease shall be 5 years
 reckoned from the first Day of June 1924
- 4 The Lessee agrees that he shall not interfere
 with any Prospector or any Digger who may
 have an agreement with the aforementioned
 Lessor in reference with grazing and watering
 his cattle and horses used in the line of Digging
 or Prospecting
- 5 The Lessee shall not assign or Sublet the
 Property hereby leased without the Consent
 in Writing of the Lessor first had and
 obtained and shall not cut trees without consent of
 the Lessor
- 6 The Lessee agrees that any person or persons
 at present on the ^{the Sand} Farm shall not be interfered
 with and that they shall be allowed to
 remain on the said Farm

7. The Lessor agrees and Covenent that - If
the Lessee keep the Condition herein contained
he shall have the free and undisturbed
occupation of the Land Property During
the Land Tenancy
