GENERAL COVERING BOND

KNOW ALL MEN WHOM IT MAY CONCERN that on this the  
11<sup>th</sup> day of May 1910 before me, NICHOLAS COLLEN  
DE KOCK of Mafeking in the Colony of the Cape of Good  
Hope, Notary Public, by lawful authority, duly admitted  
and sworn and in the presence of the subscribed  
witnesses, personally came and appeared

SOLOMON TSEKISHO PLATJE  
of Mafeking aforesaid, who acknowledged himself to be  
truly and lawfully indebted unto and on behalf of

SARAH LOUISE CLUCAS  
a widow, also of Mafeking aforesaid, her Heirs, Executors,  
Administrators or Assigns in the sum of One Hundred and  
Eighty pounds (£180) sterling of lawful money arising  
from and being for so much money lent and advanced to  
him by the said Sarah Louise Clucas, hitherto secured  
by a Promissory Note.

WHEREFORE the said Appearer renouncing all benefit from  
the legal exception "non numeratae pecuniae" and all  
other exceptions either in law or in equity which might  
or could be pleaded in bar to the validity to the said  
debt and with the full force and effect of which he  
declared himself to be perfectly acquainted, hereby  
promised and undertook to pay to the said Sarah Louise  
Clucas or her Successors, at the office of de Kock & de  
Kock, Main Street, Mafeking on the 9<sup>th</sup> day of November  
1910 the aforesaid sum of £180, for which a Promissory  
Note has this day been given by the Appearer and his sure-  
ties hereinafter mentioned, together with interest thereon  
reckoned from the 1<sup>st</sup> day of May 1910 at the rate of  
twelve per centum (12%) per annum, the interest to be  
paid monthly by the said Appearer at the office of  
de Kock

de Kock & de Kock aforesaid on the last day of each month hereafter during the continuance of this bond; And for securing the aforesaid capital sum with the interest thereon, the said Appearer declared to bind specially certain movable property principally consisting of wagons, farming implements and live stock as per Schedule hereunto annexed, the bona fide property of the said Appearer and which the said Sarah Louise Clucas shall be at liberty, on the said Appearer being sued in any Court of Law whereby the said property might be attached in execution of the judgment of any such Court and also in the event of the non-payment of any one month's interest on the aforesaid capital sum on the date the same falls due as above set forth, anything to the contrary hereinbefore contained notwithstanding, immediately to seize and sell or otherwise dispose of the same or so much of the said property as will realise the amount of the said capital sum and any interest due thereon and all expenses and costs and charges of such sale or disposal; provided that after the total amount due shall have been paid out of the proceeds aforesaid, the balance thereof, together with the remainder, if any, of the property seized, shall be paid and delivered to the said Appearer. AND for the purposes aforesaid the Appearer declared to nominate constitute and appoint the said Sarah Louise Clucas to be his true and lawful Attorney and Agent irrevocably and in rem suam, as long as any part of the said capital and any interest thereon shall remain unpaid, with power of substitution according to law. AND the Appearer also declared to refrain during the continuance and currency of this bond from selling or pledging by delivery or otherwise any or all of the property aforesaid or to


specially mortgage or hypothecate the same, to any creditor or creditors for debt or otherwise.

And the Appearer finally declared to bind generally his person and all his property both such as he is already or may in future become possessed of, movable and immovable, without exception, submitting them all and the choice thereof to constraint and execution as the law directs.

AND before me, the Notary, and witnesses, came and appeared likewise JOSHUA MOLEMA and EPHRAIM MOLEMA, both of Mafeking aforesaid, who acknowledged and agreed to bind themselves severally and jointly, to the said Sarah Louise Clucas as sureties in solidum and co-principal debtors for the due payment of the aforesaid capital sum together with all such interest as shall become due thereon and any costs and charges, expressly renouncing the beneficia ordinis seu excussionis et divisionis, with the force and effect of which they, the said sureties, acknowledged themselves to be perfectly acquainted, the first Appearer promising to free and hold harmless his said sureties in this their engagement as also to indemnify them therein, under obligation of his property according to law.

Thus done and passed at Mafeking on the day, month and year first aforewritten in the presence of George Whales and James Mildmay Faulkner Proctor, the subscribing witnesses, who together with the Appearers and me the Notary have subscribed to the original hereof now remaining in my Protocol.
