NOTICE

IS HEREBY GIVEN THAT A VERY IMPORTANT MEETING OF ALL THE
HEADS ARE HEREBY CALLED TO ATTEND A MEETING AT KUNAN ON
THE 15th DAY OF APRIL 1918. AT 10 O'CLOCK IN THE MORNING FOR
THE FOLLOWING PURPOSES:

FIRSTLY. The discussion of the Constitution .

SECONDLY. To form branch Committees for the purpose
of enrolling members and Collect their fees
for the National funds.

THIRDLY. To discuss the matter concerning the purchase
of the Farm Kunana and other landed property.

FOURTHLY. To discuss make arrangements to purchase all
stock from the people and also to discuss the
matter to buy their produce generally.

FIFTHLY. To discuss the advisability to have ~~as a stock~~
secure land to have as a stock farm, for
cattle and sheep , to improve the breed of
cattle and sheep.

Also to discuss various matters that
may be deemed advisable to the general welfare
of the people .
